**FAMILY HISTORY RESEARCH EXPLAINED  
AT FEB. 11 HISTORICAL SOCIETY MEETING**

SAUGATUCK, JAN. 30, 2009 -- Guidance for researching family histories will highlight the Saugatuck-Douglas Historical Society meeting Wednesday, February 11, at 7:00 p.m. in the Old School House Discovery Center, 130 Center Street, Douglas. Admission is free and public attendance is invited.
